Coats Woolly Ticket 12: a new machine embroidery thread for a hand-crafted effect

Uses:

Coats Woolly Tkt.12 has been developed in response to leading brand owners desire for a thread which replicates a hand-crafted effect on normal embroidery machines.

- it is used to great effect on knitwear & denim garments
- popular with leading children's and ladies wear manufacturers

Sewing Instructions

Coats Woolly is a metric ticket 12 which is much courser than 120d/2ply polyester or rayon normally used on embroidery machines. Care must be taken to digitise patterns which have lower stitch densities

Coats Woolly Tkt.12 has been specially prepared for machine sewing; normal machine speeds can be used but the best results are obtained by using a top speed of around 500-550 spm.

For best results use a size 85/13 needle with a regular point. Free test patterns are available upon request by contacting your local Coats Embroidery representative.

WARNING

This thread is substantially coarser than normal embroidery thread; use a larger needle, digitise patterns with wider stitch densities and do not use patterns designed for normal embroidery thread. Test at lower than normal machine speeds before beginning production; if in doubt contact your local Coats Embroidery representative.



Shade Range

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Warning:

The shades illustrated are designed primarily to be viewed on computer screens as a rough guide to the product shade range available; under no circumstances should they be used as a basis from placing a production order without first ordering a physical sample which can be provided upon request.

- Viewing document on computer screens: colour fidelity varies considerably between different computer screens so you may find that the same shade looks very different if viewed on another screen. On an average screen the fidelity will be good enough to distinguish that a particular shade is - for example - 'a type of green' - but not good enough to distinguish whether it is a 'kelly green' or 'dark green'; in some cases a purple may appear as a red on some screen and a 'brown' on others
- Viewing a print-out of this document: nearly all commercial PC printers have very poor colour fidelity and are not sophisticated enough to be used as a way of choosing textile shades - the print-out should never be used as the basis of placing order and may indicate a very different colour to the one intended - always request a physical sample before placing an order
